Career Trajectory and Corporate Power Structure

Precise Timeline and Advancement

- **2003:** Yale University graduation, summa cum laude, Phi Beta Kappa, History degree¹
- **2003-2014:** Goldman Sachs, 11-year tenure progressing from Real Estate Investment Banking analyst to Managing Director in Real Estate Investment Group within Asset Management Division²
- **September 2014:** Joined Blackstone specifically to "spearhead the creation of the Core+ business"³
- **2014-2024:** Built all three open-ended Core+ strategies (U.S., Europe, Asia)³
- **August 22, 2024:** Named CEO of BREIT, effective January 1, 2025⁴
- **January 1, 2025:** Became CEO of \$53 billion BREIT fund³
- **February 20, 2025:** Elected Elective Trustee at Metropolitan Museum of Art⁵

Housing Portfolio Impact - Specific Scale and Influence

Direct Property Control Through BREIT

- **Portfolio Composition:** 86% concentrated in Rental Housing, Industrial, and Data Centers⁸
- **Rental Housing Dominance:** Over 50% of BREIT's \$53 billion in rental properties¹⁵
- **Occupancy Rate:** 95% across portfolio, indicating tight market control⁸
- **Geographic Power:** Concentrated in fastest-growing U.S. markets with pricing power⁸

Documented Rent Increase Authority

LePatner's BREIT specifically implemented:

- **San Diego Properties:** 38% average rent increases (\$1,696 to \$2,339 monthly) - double market average of 20%¹⁶
- **Extreme Cases:** Individual properties saw 79% rent increases¹⁶
- **Portfolio Scale:** 66 buildings, 5,800 units in San Diego alone acquired for \$1.5 billion in 2021¹⁷
- **"Naturally Occurring Affordable Housing":** Targeted acquisition of unsubsidized affordable units for conversion to high-rent¹⁶

Eviction Strategy Implementation

- **Moratorium Lifting:** August 2022 - ended voluntary eviction freeze nationwide¹⁸
- **Florida Pattern:** 33 documented cases of eviction filing followed by 9-38% rent increases for new tenants¹⁸
- **Strategic Displacement:** Evidence of tenant harassment to circumvent California's 10% annual rent increase cap¹⁷

This expanded analysis demonstrates that Wesley LePatner was not merely "a Blackstone executive" but rather the architect of a \$53 billion housing empire with direct control over rent levels, eviction practices, and housing affordability for hundreds of thousands of American families, while simultaneously holding influential positions across elite cultural, academic, and Jewish institutional networks that shaped both economic policy and social capital distribution in major metropolitan areas.
